VICTORY AT MERC TODAY!

MNA/NNU continues to try to deny UMPNC nurses the right to vote. Another attempt failed today when the Michigan Employment Relations Commission (MERC) denied their Motion for Reconsideration.

On July 13, 2021, MERC directed an election so that the nurses can vote and decide for themselves whether they want to be represented by UMPNC – Independent Union or MNA/NNU. UMPNC – Independent Union has supported and fought for your right to vote. The MNA/NNU has repeatedly sought to delay or deny your right to vote and choose your union. MERC rejected all of MNA/NNU's attempts to delay or deny your vote.

On August 10, 2021, MERC denied MNA/NNU's Motion for Reconsideration of the direction of the election.

We hope that this is the last attempt of MNA/NNU to deny or delay your right to vote for the union of your choice. If you see the MNA/NNU, tell them it's time to stop wasting our time and dues and let us vote! We have a right to be heard and have our vote counted. The election date will be set soon, and we can get back to focusing on building our union and moving us forward together. Please keep checking your email for updates.
